

PTF Minutes – December 11, 2003

1. The meeting began with a prayer.
2. The minutes from the Nov. 13 meeting were reviewed. Chris noted that in item #3, Fall Festival Expenses were stated as \$5499.56. This figure includes funds distributed to high school classes and to teachers to purchase items for their classrooms. It should state that expenses were \$1214.66, netting a profit of \$15,778.88 to be distributed as follows: \$1009.90 to high school classes, \$3075.00 for teacher distribution, \$11,400 toward wish list items, and \$293.98 floating. Chris moved and Judy L. seconded to approve the minutes with the noted change. The motion was approved.
3. Sharon presented the financial report. Spirit items sales are great, netting \$4,600.73. The \$293 income from the Uniform Resale was from unlabelled lost and found items. The Passbook Sale will net approximately \$15,000. Chris suggested that maybe secondary students should only be given a Passbook at the beginning of the sale if they do not have elementary siblings.
4. Anita organized the Teacher Appreciation Week.
5. The current traffic situation was briefly discussed. Marquita said that traffic issues are definitely still being considered, but nothing is going to change immediately. The new traffic system needs time. Safety is the primary concern.
6. The meeting was adjourned and the Christmas party and ornament exchange began.
