1. Libby Weed opened the meeting with a prayer.
2. Michelle reviewed the budget and current numbers as prepared by Hoang Tang.
3. Anita gave a report on membership. We currently have 336 members, with \$63 income from extra calendars and \$178 income from extra directories. Mrs. Patterson's second grade class achieved the pizza party, the first to reach 100% participation. All elementary classes have reached 100% by now. The 7th grade achieved their ice cream party and secondary has reached 85% participation. A coordinator for the reward parties is still needed.
4. Mrs. Davis' class won our friendly labels and box tops contest and has already had their ice cream party last Friday. The UPC code may now be saved from Campbells/Pepperidge Farm items rather than the front labels.
5. Passbook sales end the 8th and all items and monies should be returned promptly.
6. The first Teacher Appreciation Luncheon will be held September 21 for the Ark through second grade.
7. Melinda Stockton will lead a homeroom representative meeting tomorrow morning at 8 am in the parlor.
8. Tere gave an update on the up coming Fall Festival in October.
9. Rebecca Lopez-Roper has sent out her letters of solicitation to the "big" companies for items to be donated to the Silent Auction and the committee has requested that all families donate at least one item or gift card as well.
10. The first Uniform Resale will be held November 16 with Parker Uniform items only.
11. Michelle reported there is still approximately \$4300 in unspecified funds remaining from last year. The secondary need is for 4 computers which would total around \$2150. The elementary request is for overhead projectors, a computer site license, a reading program call Reading Naturally, and new books for each teacher called 6+1 Writing.
12. Mrs. Moss updated us on the secondary playground. The school is in the process of trying to change the zoning of the school to general office. BCS is also in negotiations with the neighborhood association to get them to support this change. Negotiations also continue with the HOA regarding a fence around the area. Fundraising continues to help pay for the visual barrier hedge and remaining fencing.
13. Michelle will be leaving with her husband, Lee, to pick up Lianna in China September 14. Tere will be the "go to" person until her return September 27.
