April 4, 2007

1. Opening prayer led by Michelle.
2. We are on budget with the exception of the childcare so well provided at our meetings.
3. Open house dinner was much more successful this year, with 240 folks attending to earn \$400 for Brentwood. If Fuddruckers returns in the future, they will serve from two lines so the wait will not be as long.
4. The book fair took in \$8400 this year and earned \$2600 for Brentwood. Thanks so much to Tere for organizing and working it.
5. Michelle and Alyssa met with Dr. Weed March 30 and it was decided based on input from teachers and parents to switch to online ordering. April 16 online ordering will commence and go through June 15 to be shipped to the school with no freight, or shipped directly to homes if ordered after that with freight added. Name brand products only will be included, credit card or debit accepted.
6. Rene Blake was present and discussed Grandparents day. Letters were distributed explaining the need for national chain restaurant gift cards to be donated to the school for door prizes for this event. Rene printed the invitations herself this year and they will be sent out April 8. Anita Chambers will alphabetize the name badges this year for visitors and any others who wish to volunteer for the day before or day of should contact Rene.
7. Spaces are still available for the scrapbooking event to be held as a benefit May 5. Please see Michelle Mohrmann for details as soon as possible.
8. Mary Ellen Noth still needs help with the Uniform Resale to be held May 15 as a helper and an apprentice.

Michelle gave us an update on the HEB card program. \$45K was ordered for April so another \$1800 will be coming to Brentwood, and we are nowhere near the potential we could have from this program. Please get the word out to all those within and those you know outside the BCS community of the great good that can be done by spending no additional money and only adding one extra step to your existing routine.
10. To date \$500 has been bid on the Miami Heat autographed photo obtained by Michelle through a family contact.
11. Brainstorming on improvements for the 2007 Fall festival has begun. Underwriters and sponsors may be solicited this coming year to help eliminate expenses. Helpful suggestions or improvements for registration, silent auction, class baskets and new fundraising opportunities are also being solicited now.
12. A secondary coordinator/cheerleader is needed for the 2007 passbook sales. Having a child in grades 7-12 is not a prerequisite for the position. Kathy Baur will continue to coordinate the sale.
13. Thanks to Anne Porter who will be taking over as secretary for the PTF 2007-8 year.

14. Thanks to Rene Blake who volunteered to print the 2007-8 BCS calendar.  
Shannon Mokry volunteered to input the data for the calendar.
15. Registration for the 2007-8 school year will be August 16 and 17, with the first day of school August 22. Many volunteers are needed to help that process go smoothly. Those who are able and willing to help should contact Michelle before school is out.
16. Heidi Reich is taking over next year's math command coordinator duties from Jennifer Schrottenboer who is moving with her family to San Antonio.
17. A volunteer is needed to update and correct the data going into the 2007-8 BCS directory from the preference forms filled out during fall registration.
18. PTF had a clearance sale at the open house dinner with T-shirts, cookbooks and bracelets which raised \$184 in profit.
19. The final teacher appreciation luncheon for this year will be held May 3 and will be hosted by the 3-5 grades. Contact Melinda Stockton for details and to volunteer to help.
20. April 24 will be the Jog-A-Fun reward awards assembly. To date, \$90K has been received and many funds are still coming in.
