8. The new and wonderful HEB fundraising program is currently being unveiled. It has the potential to earn over \$100,000 for the school with no additional spending required by families - just a little planning ahead! Gift cards purchased in bulk to be used for everything from groceries, gas, prescriptions, film developing, birthday/shower presents, etc yield back to the school 1-5% return. More details to follow!
